Subject: Diversion of 8.1683 ha. of forest land for extraction of sand, stone and bajri from bed of Sheer Khad mining project by Shree Shyam Kumar, village Tikkari PO Panjain Tehsil Sadar, Distt. Bilaspur, H.P, within the jurisdiction of Bilaspur Forest Division, Distt. Bilaspur H.P. (Online Proposal No. FP/HP/MIN/34102/2018).

Kindly refer to your letter No .FC/HPC/06/57/2021 dated 12.12.2021 on the subject cited above.

2. The point wise reply to the observation as raised vide your above referred communication is submitted as below:-

1. In this regard it is submitted that the revised cost benefit analysis in ratio form duly authenticated by concerned DFO.
2. In this regard, it is submitted that the complete FRA certificate along with all consultations and meeting of the FRC and Gram Sabha are uploaded at column no. K (a) of part-I.
3. The fresh letter of intent has been uploaded at the appropriate column of part-I.
4. The user agency has intimated that the approach access from nearest existing road to proposed site is private land. There is no forest land involved in approach road. The detail report of Naib Tehsildar concerned along with revenue record of existing road has been uploaded at SN. 34 against additional information detail column of part-I.
5. The estimated reserve as mentioned in M-5.2 & M-7 has been corrected as per the approved mining plan.
6. The proposed compensatory afforestation is UPF which is waste land as per the Govt. of HP notification, 1952.
7. A certificate of DFO concerned stating that no plantation work has been carried out under any scheme in the proposed CA area has been uploaded at SN. 3 against additional information detail column of part-I.
8. The User Agency has reported that the proposed mining is district Survey Report. The comments of Mining Officer Distt. Bilaspur, HP along with Distt. Survey Report as per EMSMG 2020 & SSMMG 2016 duly issued by the

mining officer Distt. Bilaspur, HP has been uploaded at SN. 35 against additional information detail column of part-I.

9. The safety zone area has been provided and forest land of 1.5 time of the proposed area is kept as safety zone area. An undertaking of User Agency has been uploaded at SN.28 against additional information detail column of part-I.
10. The User agency has intimated that the planning of mining activities mentioned in the approved mining plan, the safe distance i.e. 1/10 of the river bed has been kept as safety zone.
11. The Brief note of the project has been uploaded at SN. 31 against additional information detail column of part-I.
12. The User Agency has intimated that project proponent has already applied for EC and public hearing was conducted, a copy of proceeding of public hearing along with certificate of user agency in this regard has been uploaded at SN. 25 & 27 respectively against additional information detail column of part-I.
13. It is intimated that earlier 16.50 ha. area was proposed for raising for CA in UPF Dhar Tatoh of Sadar range. Now the above 16.5ha area has been re identified in UPF Dhar Taroh in other portion. The digital Map, Toposheet, KML file & Land suitability certificate re identified CA area has been uploaded at the appropriate column of part-II.
