

SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF
(For forest land to be diverted under Forest Conservation Act, 1980)

A proposal has been received by this office from Executive Engineer, P.W.D. Gauchar, District- Chamoli for diversion of **1.44 Ha.** of Forest land under Forest Conservation Act, 1980 for non-forestry purpose. The project envisages transfer of Forest land of **Van Panchayat /Civil forest** for **New Construction of Simli Sheleshwar Motor Road.** I have carried out the site inspection of the land required on date **17-03-2016.**

Upon inspection of the site, the following has come to light:

1. It is found that the land required by the user agency is a RF/PF//Unclassed/Protected Forest. The break-up of the land is as under:

Revenue Forests	0.60 Ha
