Diversion of 1.3953 ha of forest land in favour of HPPWD for the construction of link road from Chintpurni Talwara (Jhurni Mod) to Nangal via Sunhet Jabbre RD 0/0 to 3/056 in District Kangra, HP, within the jurisdiction of Dehra Forest Division Distt Kangra, HP.

1. Against column No.2 of online part-II, the Legal status of forest land proposed for diversion, has not been specified, only 'other' has been mentioned. The necessary correction is required to be made against this column.

2. There is difference in employment likely to be generated, mentioned against column No.E in online part-I and given in hard copy of part-I, placed in the proposal folder. Against column No.E(ii), '5'and E(iii), '8500', has been mentioned whereas in hard copy of part-I against column No.1(vi), 'about 15000 mandays will be generated', has been mentioned. The employment details given in online part-I and placed in hard copy should match. Necessary corrections are required to be made in the employment details in online part-II.

3. Against column 8(iii), 'No', has been mentioned. As per latest instructions of GoI, the distance of the proposed projects from the WL sanctuary/ Eco-sensitive zones is required to be uploaded as an additional document against additional information details in online part-II with proper heading against remarks column. Although this certificate has been placed at P.No.60 of the proposal folder but has not been uploaded in online part-II as an additional document. Further, the name of protected area has not been mentioned in the certificate placed at P.No.60 of the proposal folder.

4. There is violation in the present proposal. But this road is not appearing in the list of 2183 road proposals supplied by HPPWD. As the case does not pertain to the list of 2183 Roads, constructed in violation of FCA. Thus as per requirement of FCA guidelines, the detailed report on violation w.r.t extent and reasons of violation in the form of self contained note supported by requisite documents, as per para 1.9 of guidelines under FCA, is to be submitted by DFO concerned in the instant case for placing the same in the proposal folder.
