Sub: Rehabilitation and Up-gradation of NH-149 from Km. 0.000 to Km. 68.280 (Pallahara to Pitiri) to two lanes with paved shoulder under NHDP-IV A in the state of Odisha on EPC mode. (Pallahara bye pass)- Proposal No. FP/OR/Road/17128/2015 dated 21.12.2015- State SI No. OR/087/2015 dated 21.12.2015.

In inviting a reference to the above cited memos on the mentioned subject, it is to inform that on scrutiny of the Compensatory Afforestation land in DSS system it is observed that the entire non-forest land measuring 4.557 ha identified for raising Compensatory Afforestation is having high dense forest growth. It is not possible to raise plantation in that land, hence the identified Compensatory Afforestation land could not be accepted for processing the diversion proposal.

In view of the above you are requested to identify a fresh Compensatory Afforestation land for the above project and submit the Compensatory Afforestation scheme accordingly as per the guidelines issued from this office vide Memo No. 23990 dated 20.12.2016 for taking necessary action at this end.
