In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's Letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 where in the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA, for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 0.0780 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favors of **Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Ltd. Meerut.** (name of user agency) for **Petrol/Deisal Pump** (purpose for diversion of forest land in **Bijnor** district falls within jurisdiction of **Asadpur Dhamrauli** village(s) in **Chanpur** tehsils.

It is further certified that:

- the complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 0.0780 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub- Division level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure I to VII annexure.
- the proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest-dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA.
- the each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of **Asadpur Dhamrauli** villages(s) is enclosed as annexure I to II annexure.
- the discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken pace only when there was a aquarium of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present,
- the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabhas have given their consent to it,
- the rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3 (1) (e) of the FRA.
