In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF) Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC (Pt.) Dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that **0.2024** hectare of forest land comprised in Sy No. 761/114pt proposed to be diverted in favour of **District police chief, palakkad** (name of user agency) for **non forestry use ie. for constructing pudur police station building** (purpose for diversion of forest land) in **Palakkad** district falls within jurisdiction of **Padavayal** village(s) in **Mannarkkad** tehsils.

- a)the complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire of forest area proposed for diversion.A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee (s) , Grama Sabha (s),Sub- Division Level Committee (s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure to annexure
- b)the proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest-dwellers ,who eligible under theFRA:
- c)the each of concerned Gram Sabha (s),has certified that all formalities /processes under the FRAhave been carried out,and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures,if any,having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion.Acopy of certificate issued by the Gram Sabha of village (s)is enclosed as annexure to annexure.....
- d)the discussion and decision on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present;
- e)the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2)of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent

to it ;

✓ (i) the rights of primitive Tribal Groups and pre- Agricultural communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1)(e) of the FRA.
