The following varies are admitted in this Forest Block:—

Channel No. 1.—The Channel raises from the north-east corner of Melapanaiyur village limit and enters into the Forest Block in S.F. No. 613/6 at 478 links from B stone No. 7 of S.F. No. 613/6 at 478 links from B Stone No. 7 of S.F. No. 613/6 of Melapanaiyur village and flows southwards, taking rain water to Veeranum Kanmoi of Virachilai I Bit village. It gets out of the Forest Block at 80 links from B Stone No. 2 of S.F. No. 546 of Virachilai I Bit village. There are three sub-channels from this Main Channel. They are as follows:—

(i) From this channel one vari diverts from west to east by taking rain water to Ayyankinmai and gets out of the Forest Block at 90 links from B Stone No. 17 of S.F. No. 613/6 of Melapanaiyur village.

(ii) Another channel diverts from the Main Channel towards west to east by taking rain water to Kanthirikanmoi and gets out of the Forest Block at 50 links from B Stone No. 1 of S.F. No. 606 of Melapanaiyur village.

(iii) Another vari branching from the Main Channel and flows to eastern side by taking rain water to Landi Kanmoi and gets out of the Forest Block at 2,200 links from B. Stone No. 1 S.F. No. 434 of Virachilai I Bit village.

Channel 2.—The Channel rises from Virachilai I Bit village limit and enters into the Forest Block in S.F. No. 434 of Virachilai I Bit village at 390 links from B Stone No. 2 of S. No. 434 generally flows towards North west by taking rain water to "Landi Kanmoi" and gets out of the Forest Block at 100 links from B Stone No. 1 of S.F. No. 435 of Virachilai I Bit village.

Channel 3.—Rising from the southern portion of the Forest Block at 1,350 links from A stone No. I of S.F. No. 10 of Athur village, generally flows north-east and then turns towards Eastern side by taking rain water to "Kadamban Kanmoi" and gets out of the Forest Block at 30 links from B Stone No. 14 of S.F. No. 434 of Virachilai I Bit village.

A part of the channel is flowing toward's western side in Athur village taking rain water to Pirandai Kanmoi and gets out of the Forest Block at 60 links from B Stone No. 1 of S.F.No.1/2 of Athur village. Another Vari rising from the southern side of the Forest Block at about 80 links from the B Stone No. 2 of S.F. No. 1/2 of Athur village, and flows towards northern side by taking rain water and joins the above channel.

Channel 4.—Rising from Channel No. 3 one branch flows to Kanjiran Urani towards northern side. Another branch flows towards north-west and turns towards south-west by taking rain water and joins the Channel No. 3 and gets out of the Forest Block.

Channel 5.—Rising from the western side of the Forest Block at 598 links from A Stone No. I of S.F. No. 613/6 of Melapanaiyur village and flows towards northern side by taking rain water to "Puliyakkanmoi" and gets out of the Forest Block at 100 links from B Stone No. 24 of S.F. No. 613/6 of Melapanaiyur village.

Channel 6.—The Channel rising from western side of Melapanaiyur village and enters into the Forest Block in S.F. No. 842 at 25 links from B Stone No. 28 of S.F. No. 613/5 and flows towards northern side taking rain water to Alagachi Urani and gets out of the Forest Block at 490 links from B Stone No. 13 of S.F. No. 583 of Melapanaiyur village.

Channel 7.—Rising from the northern side of the Forest Block in Melapanaiyur village, the vari enters into the Forest Block at 176 links from B Stone No. 11 of S.F.No. 583 generally flows towards northwest and turns towards north, north-west by taking rainwater to "Siruthandikanmoi" and gets out of the Forest Block at 25 links from B Stone No. 13 of S.F. No. 583 of Melapanaiyur village.

The above rights are admitted to the villagers to use the Channels subject to the condition that the Village Administrative Officers of Melapanaiyur village, Virachilai I Bit village, Kulipirai village, and Athur village and the Ay. cutdars of the above mentioned Kanmois should get prior permission from Forest Officials for the entry of the members of the village community for doing maintenance work.

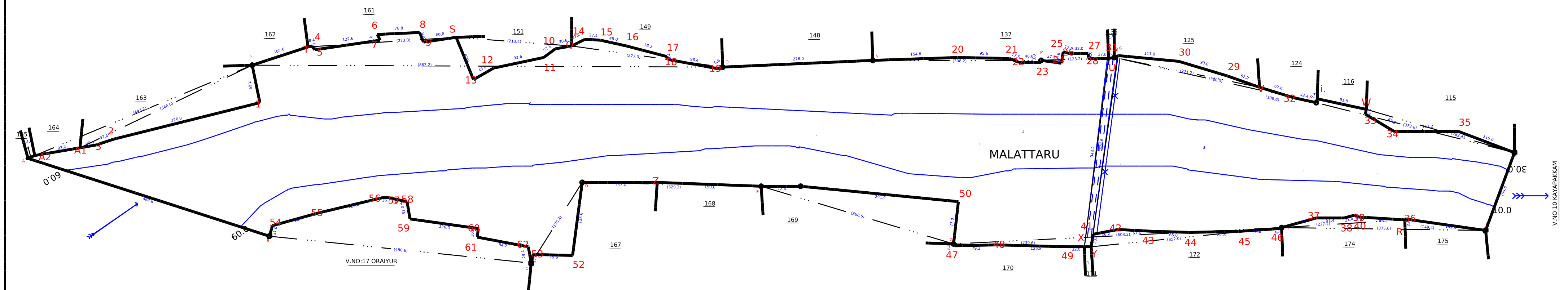
