Kindly refer to the online proposal of Government of Jammu & Kashmir on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Central Government for diversion of **3.67** ha of forest land for non-forestry purpose in accordance with section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

- 2. After careful examination of the above mentioned proposal of the State Government the following information/clarifications are still required to be submitted for further processing:
  - Total period of forest land proposed to be diverted is shown as NIL. Need to uploaded correctly.
  - (ii) Complete CA scheme to be uploaded on web portal.
  - (iii) Detailed muck disposal plan with designated muck disposal sites on non-forest land to be
  - (iv) Detailed muck disposal plan with financial implications to be submitted.
  - (v) DSS/google earth shows that the total KML file of CA site is 3.48 ha out of which 3.48 hectare vacant space is available. Additional area of 3.86 hectare is required for fulfilling target plantation of twice degraded forest land.
- 3. The compliance to the above may be submitted within 30 days from the date of issue of this letter failing which the proposal shall be liable to be rejected for want to information.
