

EDS dated 18-03-2016 FP/UK/ROAD/10588/2015

1. Short narrative of the project does not give adequate information in Part I.
2. Village wise break up is not provided in correct form in Part I.
3. Total period for which forest land to be diverted is not mentioned in Part I.
4. In the component wise break up in Part I, mentioned "TWO" which is not clear.
5. GPS coordinate marked digitally on GIS software generated georeferenced map for the area proposed for diversion in 200-300m distance and each turn of the proposed road and be uploaded in the designated place in Part I.
6. In the Sol toposheet uploaded in Part I, the starting point and end point is not marked.
7. GPS coordinate marked digitally on georeferenced map for every corner of land proposed for CA is not provided. It should be uploaded in the designated place in Part I.
8. CA stipulation is not commensurate with the total forest land diverted in the district in Part II need justification and correction.
9. The 77 trees per hectare do not account for 0.4 density and the NPV calculation is also done for dense forest which needs review. The State Govt may review the density and NPV and furnish revised density and NPV calculation.
10. In the SIR report of the DFO, comments on all points are not done. SIR report, covering reply on all points may be provided.
11. Part I, II, III, IV and V which is provided in online web portal for the proposal may also be enclosed with the hard copy for further necessary action.
