General Description:

- 1) The Legal status of the A forest land proposed for diversion is unclassified Forest.
- Maps of the site are submitted. 2)

- 4) In addition to the above forest land, 59.92 ha non-forest land is required for the project.
- 5) The estimated cost of the project is Rs. 1,19,020 lakh and manpower to be generated, Permanent-04 & Temporary-85 Person.
- 6) Cost-benefit analysis not submitted. The proposed irrigated area is 63548 .ha.
- Density of vegetation is 0.2. No trees are marked for felling on the proposed forest land..
- It has been certified that the requirement of proposed forest land is unavoidable & barest minimum. Details regarding exploration of alternatives and the suitability of present alternative on a map & comparative analysis at is submitted.
- 9) There is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act., 1980.
- 10) The proposed forest land does not form any part of National Park/Wildlife Sanctuary/Biosphere Reserve/Tiger Reserve/Elephant Corridor etc. and proposed project is outside 10 km of the boundaries of the nearest protected area.

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Accordingly, REC *in-principle approves* the proposal for diversion of 22.6756 ha Protected Forest land for widening and strengthening up to four lanning of Kheda-Dholka road Km. 36/600 to Km. 53/200 in favour of Executive Engineer, Kheda R&B Division (State) in Kheda District of Gujarat for Stage-I approval on standard terms and conditions.

However, Stage-I shall be issued only after submission of following documents:

1. Submission and uploading of KML and CA map for 46.00 ha of degraded forest land.

2. The revised site specific CA scheme shall be submitted as per the Para 2.8 (iii) of FCA Handbook 2019 and shall include the following points also:

a) Standard size Saplings to be planted (Minimum standard height and minimum collar girth species wise) as approved by the State Govt.

b) Soil & moisture conservation works.

c) Regeneration cleaning.

d) Silvicultural and other activities as prescribed in the working plan including all stumps upto 90 cm dressing of coppicing species from ground level.

e) Species to be planted (species wise number of plants).

f) Details of proposed monitoring mechanism and outcome parameters.

g) Technical and administrative approvals from the Competent Authority for current year.

h) The CA scheme shall have 10 year maintenance excluding the plantation year.

- i) Detailed work scheduled involved in 10 years maintenance and year wise operation and amount to be incurred.
- j) Recording of height and collar girth species wise at the time of plantation, once every year and at the end of maintenance year.
- k) Recording of stump dressing girth wise and species wise.
- 1) The revised CA scheme shall be uploaded on e.portal

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
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- 5. The estimated cost of the project is Rs. 85 Crore and employment generation- 200 permanent person and 50 temporary person.
- 6. Cost-Benefit analysis is available.
- Density of vegetation is 0.0 and there are 3276 trees are marked for felling on the proposed forest land.
- It has been certified that the requirement of proposed forest land is unavoidable & barest minimum.
 Details regarding exploration of alternatives alignment and the suitability of present alternative map is not applicable due to road widening.
- There is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act. 1980. No work on non-forest land has been taken up.
- 10. Certificate of Collector (for FRA) is available.

Observation of RO Bhopal.

- The widening of road is proposed 42.46625 ha and KML file is submitted for 73.70 ha. The length of KML 32.00 ha which is, correct as per requirement, however, due to width the variation in area of KML file is observed.
- 2) As per DSS CA area of 50.30 ha shows MDF in 11.00 ha.
- 3) The CA scheme is not in accordance to para 2.8(iii) of FCA handbook, 2019. The CA scheme is proposed for 858 plant per ha.




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Recommendations of REC:

The REC examined the proposal for diversion of forest land under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The REC also saw the proposal on the Decision Support System (DSS) of FSI.

Accordingly, REC in-principle approves the proposal for diversion of 42.46625 ha Protected Forest land for the project of Widening & Strengthening four lane of Mitha Tharad Deesa Road (Section Deesa-Lakhani road) Ch. 56/340 to 88/390Ta. Deesa & Lakhni, District Banaskantha in favour of Executive Engineer, R&B Division, Palanpur, Gujarat for Stage-I approval on standard terms and conditions and following specific condition:

However, Stage-I shall be issued only after receipt of following information:

1. The widening of road is proposed 42.46625 ha and KML file is submitted for 73.70 ha. The length of KML 32.00 ha which is, correct as per requirement, however, due to width the variation in area of KML file is observed. Thus, correct KM file of the proposed road of 42.46625 ha excluding blacktop road.

The revised site specific CA scheme shall be submitted as per the Para 2.8 (iii) of FCA Handbook 2019 and shall include the following points also:

a) Standard size Saplings to be planted (Minimum standard height and minimum collar girth species wise) as approved by the State Govt.

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b) Soil & moisture conservation works.

c) Regeneration cleaning.

d). Silvicultural and other activities as prescribed in the working plan including all stumps upto 90 cm dressing of coppicing species from ground level.
