



Accordingly, REC *defers* the proposal for diversion of Diversion of 36.00 ha Reserved forest land for construction of Ganga Bawari Tank project in favour of Water Resources Division in Nemach district of MP for want of following informations:

- 1. The DSS analysis and google earth show the construction work in the forest land which attract Para 1.21 of FCA Handbook 2019 for violation in Forest Land. Thus detailed report shall be submitted on following points
  - a. The proposal for Penal NPV as per the Para 1.21 (ii) of FCA Handbook 2019.
  - b. The proposal for Penal CA from the State Govt. of MP.
  - c. The State Govt shall submit the details report as per Para 1.21 (ii) a,b,c & d of FCA Handbook 2019.
