Sub:- Implementation of Kuriarkutty- Karappara Irrigation Project – Joint verification of Proposed project area – reg.

Attention is invited to the above subject. During the final discussion on 09.03.2022 inconnection with scrutiny of the proposal for survey works related to the Implementation of Kuriarkutty- Karappara Irrigation Project (SAKKIP), the following points may be furnished for taking further actions in this regard.

1. Disposal of debris produced during the survey was sought vide ref. 2nd cited and vide ref.3rd cited, it replied that there will not be any debris resulting due to the investigations. But, on scrutiny of the proposal and site inspection, it is found that huge quantity of debris will be produce during the time of drifting tunnel (1.8m (W) x 2.1m (H)) at various locations, borehole drilling in 76mm diameter and headrace tunnel etc. So how much forest area is needed for dumping of debries produced during the survey works may be furnished.
2. Whether any additional road access other than existing forest road is needed for using the machinery of Drifting Tunnel etc or any of the proposed works.
