- Site specific CA site as per provision contained under Para 2.8 of FCA guidelines.
- Action taken report against the person responsible for violation from the DFO.
- Calculation of Penal NPV is seemingly incorrect. The figures may be rechecked and verified for accuracy as per the provision under Para 1.21 (ii) (a)
- Site suitability certificate of CA site has not been submitted. It has been seen in the DSS that the site is rocky/tough terrain. DFO to confirm suitability.
