With reference to the aforementioned letters on the captioned subject, it is requested to deposit the amount of ₹ 27,14,25,338/- (**Rupees twenty-seven crore fourteen lakh twenty-five thousand three hundred thirty-eight**) only as depicted hereunder towards additional NPV over 51.418 ha broken up Non-Forest land treated as Forest as on 25.10.1980 as 20% for each year (Eco Value Class – I based on forest type- 3C/C2e (iii) Moist Peninsular Valley Sal and canopy Density – 0.3) in respect of Nuagaon Iron Ore Miens of Sri Kamaljeet Singh Ahluwalia. The NPV amount has to be deposited through **e-portal** of MoEF&CC as provided in the <http://forestclearance.nic.in> and the proof/evidence of the deposit of fund be submitted to this office for further necessary action at this end. Nonetheless, it is also requested to provide undertaking as regards payment of NPV over the said land if required so.



X. Sub:

Identification of degraded forest land for Compensatory Afforestation and Penal Compensatory Afforestation.

This is to apprise that degraded forest land is required for Compensatory Afforestation and Penal Compensatory Afforestation in respect of the aforementioned Diversion Proposal. In this context, it is requested that degraded forest land under the jurisdiction of your Range be identified and intimated to the extent as detailed hereunder-

Particulars	Extent of area required (ha.)
Compensatory Afforestation	253.20
Penal Compensatory Afforestation	51.418
Total	304.618

In addition, it is requested that the following points be adhered to during identification of degraded forest land for aforementioned Afforestation schemes.

1. The identified degraded forest land should be a contiguous patch with canopy density below 0.4 (Ideal range of Canopy Density- 0.1 - 0.2).
2. It should be ensured that the site identified is not allotted earlier to any other project.
3. The identified site should be properly demarcated with 4' height RCC pillars as per extant guideline.
4. DGPS/ GPS coordinates of all posted pillars along with pillar number and distance between pillar should be inscribed in the RCC pillar.
5. Delineation of the identified site along with DGPS/ GPS reading should be well reflected in the map prepared thereof.
6. A durable sign board depicting the name of the project, scheme, year, coupe, compartment and status of the forest land along with the extent of area should be erected at a conspicuous location of the identified site.
7. A suitable treatment map showing the details of areas fit for plantation along with required soil moisture conservation measures and silvicultural operations should be prepared.
8. The average number of seedlings that can be planted per ha basis should be reflected in the treatment map.

N.B:- It is mentioned that the identified site should be demarcated only after confirmation of Canopy Density as depicted herein above.
