Extentionof Agar Jingor Motor Road to Vasisem Lagga Akaswara (2.31 ha)

Following shortcomings are still not addressed in the proposal which may be attended by the State Govt.:-

- 1. The digital map of area proposed for CA uploaded at para-L (v) of Part-I online in response to point no.-3 of EDS dated 05.02.2016 is provided on google earth map which does not serve any useful purpose May provide/upload GIS software generated geo referenced digital map of the area proposed for CA providing geo coordinates at all corner points in shape (polygon/closed area) file.
- 2. Instead of providing justification for locating the project in the forest land at para-D (i) of Part-I online in response to point No.-4 of EDS dated 05.02.2016, a certificate have been provided stating that no alternate land is available without giving any reasons or details of the alternates examined.
- 3. Though FRA certificate has now been uploaded but proceedings of the meeting of Gram Sabha Lakheri have been provided instead of Gram Sabha Akaswara which is the only village mentioned in the village wise breakup at para- B 2.3 of Part-I online.
- 4. Reply to point No.-6 of this office EDS dated 05.02.2016, reveals that only 434.32 ha CA target has been achieved in Kedarnath Wild Life Division, Gopeshwar against diversion 1031.955 ha forest land since 1980 and no CA has been carried out after 2007-08. The reason given in the reply for not accomplishing CA target is non-availability of funds which does not appear convincing and requires comments at State Govt. level. Moreover, CA stipulated against 1031.955 ha forest land diverted since 1980 is still shown as 434.32 ha in para-14 of Part-II online, which is not correct. May show correct target of CA stipulated and also provide year wise plan for accomplishing balance CA targets.
- 5. Details of the employment likely to be generated not found uploaded online in Part-I either in para-E or in additional documents.
- 6. Duly signed copy of form –A Part-II to V not found uploaded in Part-I online though stated so in the reply.
- 7. The reply to point NO.-10 of this office EDS dated 05.02.2016 is not convincing. In view of involvement of large number of trees specially Oak trees, State Govt. may give a serious consideration to find alternates, if not over the entire alignment in parts, to reduce the number of trees as it may not be possible to consider the proposal in its present form.
- 8. As per Decision Support System (DSS) Analysis, in the KML file of area proposed for CA, uploaded in para-L (iv) C of Part-I online the extent of CA area is 7.15 ha instead of 5.04 ha and out of this 1.00 ha area is on moderately dense forest. May upload KML file again for correct extent of C area i.e. 5.04 ha after replacing 1.00 of moderately dense forest with some other area suitable for CA. Revised digital map and SoI topohseet map may also be uploaded/provided accordingly along with suitability certificate.
