Sub: Diversion of 0.597 ha (*revised from 0.1689 ha*) of forest land in Bukkasagar Sy no. 551, Venkatapura Sy No. 903, Kanive Thimmalapura Sy No. 191, 133 & 258, Kamalapura Hobli, Hosapete Taluk, Ballari District for providing combined water supply scheme (CWSS) to Bukkasagara, Devasamudra and other 5 villages in Hospet Taluk, Ballari District in favour of the Assistant Executive Engineer, Rural Drinking Water Supply & Sanitation Department, Rural Water Supply Sub Division, Hospet Ballari District. **Proposal No.FP/KA/WATER/19533/2016**


With reference to the above subject, the proposal (PART-I, II & III) received vide Ref (1) & (2) has been examined. It is noticed that there is a revision of extent from 0.1689 ha to 0.597 ha during field processing and subsequent EDS query raised by the DCF. The User Agency (UA) has made certain changes while re-submitting the proposal and introduced incorrectness/inconsistency in some Items of PART-I. Following variations/shortcomings are noticed in the revised proposal.

PART-I	
Item A-1(vii) Area of forest land proposed for diversion(in ha.)	An extent of 0.597 ha of forest land is proposed for diversion in this Item as well as in Item B-2.1, 2.3, B-2.3, B-2.4. However, the <u>KML file as well as the Forest area break up in the document uploaded at Sl No. 1 of Additional Information details shows the forest requirement as 0.169 ha (1690 m x 1m). The UA needs to provide the consistent and uniform information in all relevant Items of PART-I by making corrections wherever necessary.</u>
Item B-2.3: Village wise Break up	Forest and Non-forest land requirement is shown as 0.169 ha and 6.745 ha respectively, as against corresponding figures of 0.597 ha and 6.745 ha shown in Item A-1(viii) & (ix). As per ICT Centre Report, the project involves forest diversion in Bukasagara Village Sy no. 549 & 550 instead of Sy No. 551.

	<p>UA needs to verify this issue in consultation with field officers and then make necessary corrects, if required. Further, it needs to provide the consistent and uniform information of area in all relevant Items of PART-I by making corrections wherever necessary.</p>
Item B-2.4: Component wise Break up	<p>Forest and Non-forest land requirement is shown as 0.597 ha and <u>0.645 ha</u> as against corresponding figures of 0.597 ha and <u>6.745 ha</u> shown in Item A-1(viii) & (ix). The UA needs to provide the consistent and uniform information in all relevant Items of PART-I by making corrections wherever necessary.</p>
Item C(ii)(b): KML File of Patches	<p>Four (4) KML files with 'Line' feature' without assigning proposer <i>File Names</i> have been uploaded. The KML file (with red colour) showing length of 1690 meter has been uploaded and thus the forest extent comes to 0.169 ha (1690 m length x 1 m width specified elsewhere). The UA needs to upload the correct KML files and with distinctly identifiable <i>File Names</i> matching with GPS readings correctly.</p>
Item C(iii) Copy of Survey of India Toposheet indicating boundary of forest land proposed to be diverted	<p>Instead of Topo Map, satellite Imagery has been uploaded. The UA needs to upload Topo Map (Survey of India Topo Sheet) on 1:50,000 scale showing the boundary of forest land proposed for diversion, ensuring that the Topo Map carries TOPO Sheet Number, Map Index and is ink-signed by User Agency.</p>
Item C(iv) Scanned copy of the Geo-referenced map of the forest land proposed to be diverted prepared by using GPS or Total Station	<p>Instead of Geo-referenced Map (Village map showing the boundary of forest land proposed for diversion along with GPS readings) Topo Map is uploaded. The UA needs to upload the Geo-referenced Map (Village map showing the boundary of forest land proposed for diversion along with GPS readings (datum: WGS 84; in Degree.decimals), ensuring that (i) the Map has a proper Map Index, (ii) the Map is ink-signed by User Agency and (iii) the Map shows project alignment in forest as well as non-forest land (in two different colours) within the limits of such village.</p>
<p>D(ii) Whether a copy of map indicating location of alternative examine is required to be provided</p> <p>D(ii)(a) Reason for not providing such map:</p>	<p>'No' is selected in Item D(ii) and the text '<i>Alternate alignment for laying the pipeline is too</i>' is given as the reason for not uploading the map indicating location of alternative examined UA.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The UA needs to examine at least 2-3 alternative alignment to avoid the use of forest land for the project. 2. The Map on appropriate scale (preferably on satellite imagery) showing such alternatives and also the presently proposed alignment needs to be uploaded in Item D(ii)(a) duly ensuring that such Map carries proper Map Index and is also ink-signed by UA. 3. The UA is also required to upload the detailed reasons for discarding such alternatives in favour of presently proposed alignment through forest land. <p>Please note that without such details the proposal is likely to be returned by the Government.</p>
Item I. (iii) Status of approval of the	<p>The text '<i>Application yet to be submitted</i>' is given. The UA is required to upload a parallel online application seeking wildlife</p>

Standing Committee of National Board for the Wildlife (NBWL) to the Project	clearance from National Board for Wildlife.
Additional Information Details/ General	The UA is required to remove all obsolete documents (such as document at Sl No. 1) or documents already uploaded in other Items of PART-I.

PART-I & II	Only the prints taken directly from FC web portal and ink-signed by the UA (for PART-I) and by DCF (for PART-II) need to be submitted.
