Subject: Diversion of 0.9714 ha of forest land in Yadadri Bhuvanagiri Division for establishment of PACO 25 tower for phase II network in Greater Hyderabad Police Commissionerate in favour of Commissioner of Police, Rachakonda Commissionerate-reg.

Madam,

Please refer to the above cited letter on the subject, in this regard I am to request to furnish the following additional information / documents / clarification at the earliest for further consideration of the proposal.

1. The User Agency has submitted proposal for diversion of only 0.0705 Ha of forest land and all the undertakings are also given for this 0.0705 Ha Forest area only. Whereas the DFO in his report has submitted the proposal for 0.9714 Ha considering the road connectivity to the proposed APCO 25 Tower. Hence, revised proposal in Form-I along with undertakings showing the revised area may be obtained from the UA and submitted.
2. DFO in his recommendation indicated strengthening of 1.638 Km pathway: It is not clear whether the pathway is the proposed road or something else. The requirement of road may be obtained from the User Agency.
3. As regards to CA is concerned, in terms of para 2.6 of FC guidelines, the scheme shall be for 10 years maintenance, whereas the SFD has prepared CA scheme with only 7 years of maintenance. The same may be revised by the SFD.
4. The proposed road alignment is having very sharp bends at 4-5 places, and it appears not suitable for plying with heavy load trucks. Hence the same needs to be realigned by technically competent authority.
