defer the proposal to the next REC mee **Open with** wing points:

1. State Government may submit the component wise breakup of the area proposed for diversion along with the justification of allocating such area for each component. The area requirement for each component should be minimum and duly authenticated in view of norms/ guidelines of MHA or other competent authority.


Agenda Item No.04: Diversion of 12.33 ha of forest land for construction of motor Road from Haldwani Bypass Road to Halduchor Indian Oil Depot in Lalkuan Constituency Distt Nainital Under C.M. Announcement No. 310/2013, in favour of PWD within the Jurisdiction of Tarai East, Haldwani Forest Division, District Nainital, Uttarakhand. (Online Proposal No. FP/UK/ROAD/29571/2017)

Regional Empowered Committee discussed the proposal seeking diversion of 12.33 ha of forest land for construction of motor Road from Haldwani Bypass Road to Halduchor Indian Oil Depot. The committee noted that 562 trees (in 9 mtr width) are proposed to be affected in the project. It is noted that the forest land proposed for diversion is not a part of any Protected Area and no rare and endangered species of flora and fauna have been reported in the area proposed for diversion. Further, no violation of FCA has been reported by the State Government. The concerned DFO along with the user agency gave a detailed representation of the project before the committee. It was observed that a national highway NH-84 is near to the proposed alignment and the user agency informed the committee that the widening of the NH-84 has just taken place.

After detailed discussion on various aspects of the proposal, the committee decided to defer the proposal to the next REC meeting with following points:

1. The DFO has mentioned that the area proposed for diversion is 'prone to erosion' therefore, the State Government will provide the structures and detailed budgetary provisions in the project to mitigate the erosion in the area.
2. The State Government may submit the enumeration list of tree counted in the 7 meter width of the proposed alignment.
3. The widening work of NH-84 is going on at present which should solve the problem of traffic congestion on this route. In such a situation, proposing a bypass after felling 562 trees does not seem to be justified. A proper technical justification of the proposed bypass road is required to be provided with facts.

The meeting ended with thanks to the members and other participants.
