
Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to online proposal no. FP/MZ/SCH/148602/2021 on PARIVESH portal by Govt. of Mizoram on the above-mentioned subject seeking prior approval of Central Government in accordance with Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. In this regard, it is informed that the proposal was discussed in the Forest Advisory Committee (FAC) in its meeting held on 13.06.2022. The detailed minutes of the said FAC meeting is uploaded in the parivesh.nic.in. After through deliberation, the FAC deferred the proposal and desired following information to be furnished:-

- i. The IRO, Shillong along with Nodal Officer (FC) shall carry out site inspection of the area and submit the detailed site suitability report for selection of the current site and its site specificity.
- ii. The State Government may submit the detailed Land-use plan of the total area proposed for diversion i.e. 63.441 ha.
- iii. State Forest department to submit the action taken report regarding action against responsible person for the violations done under FCA 1980.

In view of above, it is requested that the State Government may kindly submit the information/documents as stated above to this Ministry for further consideration of the proposal.
