Hence, he is requested to furnish the Recognition of Forest Rights(RoFR) Certificate issued by the concerned District Collector to the Government immediately keeping in view of the handbook of guidelines issued by Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India vide Letter F.No.5-2/2017-FC, dt.28.03.2019, in supersession of all guidelines issued in the past, which is applicable from 8th March, 2019 onwards, for taking further necessary action in the matter.
