Sir,

Kindly refer to the online proposal of Government of Jammu & Kashmir on the abovementioned subject seeking prior approval of the Central Government for diversion of 6.938 ha of forest land for non-forestry purpose in accordance with section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

- After careful examination of the above-mentioned proposal of the Govt of J&K the following information/clarifications are still required to be submitted:
  - (i) Rationalization of routes as per inspection report of DFO Billawar to be done. All efforts to be made to minimize damage to pristine patches of forest as mentioned in DFO inspection note.
