In the village wise breakup only village "Jalai" is mentioned in online Part-I, where
as in FRA certificate village level proceedings are produced for village "Jalai and "
Kandara".

Action Required:- The State Govt. may remove this anomaly.

2. In the hard copy the certificate shows that the distance of the proposed road from wild life sanctuary/ National Park is less than 10 Km.

<u>Action Required:</u> The State Govt. will provide the comments from Chief Wild Life Warden.

- 3. In DSS analysis it is observed that of the proposed road passes through the CA area.

  Action Required:—The State Govt. may calculate total area proposed for CA..
- 4. Justification is not authenticated by DFO.

<u>Action Required:</u> The State Government may provide the justification duly authenticated by DFO.

- 5. Administrative approval uploaded online is for the year 2008 and not clear <a href="Action Required:-">Action Required:-</a> State Govt. may upload the clear copy of Administrative approval and also clarify whether re-validation done, if required.
- 6. CA scheme not found uploaded.

Action Required: State Govt. may upload the CA scheme.

- 7. At para 8 (iii) in Part-II, mentioned 'Yes' and submitted that no negative impact in agriculture field but Chief Wildlife Warden certificate is required.
  - <u>Action Required</u>:- State Govt. may provide the Chief Wildlife Warden certificate to this office.
- 8. The proposed road has two segments that connect the existing road. One segment is found to connect the village with existing road which appears quite justified. Other segment links two existing roads and cuts through dense forest thereby is unjustified.

  Action required: The State Govt. may review the proposed as it is not found justified in the existing proposed road segments.
