

**5.96 ha Forest Land in favour of HPPWD C/O link road from Daand to Bhasua within jurisdiction of Churah Forest Division**

Following shortcomings may be attended by the State Government:

1. At B 1 of Part I online, it is mentioned that in-principal approval has been received for 2.5 ha. Name of the project for which approval has been obtained, may be mentioned.
2. At B 2.3 Part I, name of village has been mentioned as Daand to Bhasua which does not appear to be correct. Village wise breakup for area proposed for diversion may be given.
3. In KML file the take off point of proposed road from existing roads is not shown, which may be done. The road appears to be far from both the villages as seen in the google earth map, hence the depiction on KML file of the proposed road may be reviewed.
4. At C (iii), the copy of the SoI toposheet appears to be a photograph rather than scanned copy, without showing the toposheet no. And lat-long no.s, hence may be resubmitted after removing these shortcomings in both hardcopy and correction made online.
5. In the digital map submitted online and uploaded at C (iv), geo-coordinates are required to be shown at an interval of every 200-300 mts as well as at all turns which may be done and resubmitted in hard copy as well as correction made online.
6. It is observed that alternatives have been explored as refelected in copy of SoI toposheet submitted but no mention of same is made at sl. No. D (ii) of Part I online, which may be done.
7. Since the area affected is more than 05 ha hence, cost benefit analysis and C:B ratio needs to be worked out. In the hard copy submitted, parameters for loss and benefits have been mentioned but these have not been quantified which would enable calculation of ration of Cost to benefit, which may be done and uploaded online at G.
8. From the FRA certificate, it is seen that Dand , Langoie , Darobdi , Ghanetra , Bhasuwa villages are involved but area affected in each village and that the Committee in Gram Sabha had considered this proposal of PWD does not find mention in the annexures for proceedings of SDO as well. Hence corrected documents may be submitted in hard copy in original/attested and uploaded online.
9. Geo-coordinates of muck dumping sites may be provided.
10. Density of vegetation appears to have been given in % which may be given in decimal.
11. It is mentioned that no wildlife is present in the area at Sl no. 8 of Part II which does not appear to be correct. Hence needful data may be given

12. In the data on progress of CA at Sl no. 14 of Part II, the area for CA including PCA is mentioned as 211.18 and progress of CA is shown as 490.64 ha which appears to be anomalous hence may be re-examined and corrected.
13. As per DSS analysis of CA area proposed, 1ha is seen as MDF which may be corrected incorporating area without MDF and corrected map/data provided.  
Hence needful correction may be done.
