


Subject: Diversion of 1.193 ha of forest land in Kamareddy division for Improvement and upgradation of WBM surface road to BT standards from Yellareddypally to Kattakindi thanda in Rajampet mandal in Kamareddy District in favour of PR department, Kamareddy District-Reg

Reference: The State Government Letter No 323/For.I(1)/2022 dated 03.02.2022

Madam.

With reference to the subject and reference cited above, I am directed to request to provide the following additional information / documents / clarification at the earliest to this office for further consideration of the proposal.

- 1. As informed by the state government, the forest area proposed for diversion falls under Pocharam Wildlife Sanctuary, hence approval / permission from the competent authorities under Wildlife Protection Act, 1972 may be submitted.
- 2. The FDO in his site inspection report it is categorically mentioned that "the area is free from encroachments and claims in the RF area that attracts the RoFR 2006 and no claims pending in RoFR Act 2006". However, as per the Google time series images, several houses and agricultural activities are noticed within the RF area and on either sides of the road portion. Hence, clarification on above matter and legal status of such residential and agricultural activities may be submitted.
- 3. Legality of villages/Thandas needs to be furnished along with copies of gazette notification vide which these villages are notified.
- 4. The legal status of the existing road along with relevant document may be submitted.
- 5. Detailed design and component wise breakup of the road i.e. BT portion / drainage / shoulders etc along with proper justification for 10 mtrs width may be furnished.
- 6. As informed in the past, it is noticed that proposal has been processed at all processing authorities on the same day i.e. 06.04.2022 and forwarded to IRO, Hyderabad on 06.04.2022. However, as per the documents submitted along with the proposal it is

noticed that processing authorities have dealt the proposal at different dates. Hence, appropriate direction must be given to all concerned officials to follow the procedure as per the instruction of the Ministry and to process the proposal instantly at their level.

7. PART II, site inspection report, countersigning of SOI toposheets etc to be mandatorily done by the concerned DFO. However, in the instant case PART II, SIR etc are filled by the FDO. Suitability of NFL for CA, CA Scheme and various documents uploaded are to be signed by the DFO concerned which is not being complied in this case. Revised proposal incorporating above may be submitted at the earliest for further necessary action please.
