


Subject: Diversion of 7.5 Ha of forest land for Construction of Road from Dhikoniya to Talawara under RIDF(VC) Scheme in Rajasthan in Baran Forest Division.

Reference: Reply of EDS submitted on line by the State Government of Rajasthan

Dear Sir,

On the above mentioned subject, I am directed to inform that this office has received an online proposal for clearance under Forest (Conservation) Act-1980. The details of the proposal are as given below-

Some information was sought vide letter of even number dated 2<sup>nd</sup> Mar 2015. The reply of this letter was submitted on line by the State Government. In the meantime, Hard copy of the proposal was also received in this office. As per the information made available, the following shortcoming have been observed in the proposal-

- a) The shortcomings in KML file was pointed out in our letter dated 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2015 but it has not been removed. The KML file is not showing the alignment of the road and proposed area of Compensatory Afforestation.
- b) In part-I, it has been mentioned by the user agency that for present proposal, the forest land is required in two villages namely **Piplada** and **Talawara** whereas the proceedings of gram sabha meeting have been attached for the village **Todian**.
- c) The proceedings of Sub-Divisional level Committee are general without specifically mentioning the name of villages and the required forest land.

DCF-Baran has mentioned the same reference number (8B/Raj/06/ 07/2015/FC/1162 dated 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2014) in almost all the reply of EDS related to Baran Forest Division. The mentioned reference number is not related to the present proposal. The DCF-Baran may be advised to be cautious in future, for mentioning relevant reference number of the proposal to avoid confusion.

The above discrepancies may be removed so that further action can be taken. However, the present proposal will be discussed in the REC Meeting scheduled to be held on 28<sup>th</sup> July 2015.
