Subject: Diversion of 2.6325 Ha of forest land in Asifabad division for Laying of BT road from PWD road to Jhaduguda of Jainoor Mandal of Komarambheem Asifabad District in favour of PR Dept, Asifabad District -reg

## Madam,

Please reference to the subject and reference cited above and I am directed to request to furnish the following additional documents/information at the earliest to this office for further consideration of the proposal;

- i. As per the provision of FC rules 2022, in case the non-forest land or portion thereof provided by the user agency is not fit for raising Compensatory Afforestation of a specified density, then additional Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised on a degraded notified or unclassed forest land under the management control of the Forest Department which is twice in size of such shortfall in the given Compensatory Afforestation land and the user agency shall also bear the additional cost on such account. In view of the above provision, the CA areas identified and CA scheme submitted may be re-examined and submit required area for CA and CA scheme shall be as per the provision of FC rules 2022;
- ii. Proper documentary evidence like RF notification etc on existing road i.e. RoW allowed or otherwise, if allowed, actual length and width of the road allowed etc shall be submitted.
- iii. From the toposheet, it can be seen that there are 7 bridges/culverts proposed in the forest land. However, the forest land proposed for diversion in such places is only 7.5 m in width only. Specific comment is requested from the UA on whether construction of bridges/culverts is possible in the 7.5 m width proposed for diversion without breaking up the adjacent forest land not proposed for the diversion.
