**विषय:** **Diversion of 3.677 ha of forest land in favour of HPPWD for the construction of link road from Nadal to village Jatrahan (Kms. 0/0 to 7/00), within the jurisdiction of Churah Forest Division Distt. Chamba, HP. (Online Proposal No. FP/HP/Road/50036/2020).**

महोदय,

उपरोक्त विषय पर संदर्भित पत्र का आशय ग्रहण करते हुए सूचित करना है कि प्रस्ताव में निम्नलिखित कमियां पार्ई गयी हैं। अतः राज्य सरकार निम्न बिन्दुओं पर आवश्यक सूचनाएं प्रेषित करने का कष्ट करें, ताकि अग्रिम कार्यवाही सुनिश्चित की जा सके:—

1. Administrative Approval of the project needs to be provided
2. The State Govt. may provide/upload a brief note of the project under Additional information
3. The KML file shows that only two beneficiary villages have been marked in the KML. However, as per the information provided in Part-I, there are **five** villages.
4. It has been observed from the KML file that alignment is passing through Agriculture land. Therefore, comments of the DFO on whether this is a part of Non-Forest Land or Encroachment on Forest Land may be provided.
5. The layout plan must include a legend and the proper dimensions of each component, such as Carriageway, Paved Shoulder, Earth Filling, Drain, and Protection Work, as well as an area-wise calculation that is countersigned by the concerned DFO. Furthermore, the forest land and non-forest land involved in the proposal must be represented in the layout plan with distinct colours.
6. From the KML file, it can be observed that the alignment of the road in village Kunda overlaps the existing road. Therefore, the KML file shall be rectified to avoid overlapping
7. As per the KML, it is observed that there is an existing path/road. State Govt. may provide the details on whether it is already constructed. If yes, whether approved under FC was obtained or not, details for the same may be provided.
8. NPV calculation sheet/Bills are required to be revised as per the direction by MoEF&CC dated 06.01.2022
9. The Abstract of Trees and Enumeration list, duly authenticated by the concerned DFO, needs to be provided.
10. It has been observed from KML and can be further confirmed from the geologist report that the dumping site is on a steep slope from where the debris can be easily rolled down into Rivulets/household/Agriculture fields. State Govt. may ensure effective protection measures before any dumping is made to avoid spillage of muck
11. All the dumping sites are proposed on forest land. The state government shall explore non-forest land for the same. If a dumping site is necessarily required to be proposed in forest land, the area of forest land involved in muck dumping shall be reduced. Further, a separate enumeration list of trees for the dumping site may be provided.
12. The Muck Management Plan needs to be duly authenticated by the Concerned DFO.
13. The Reclamation Plan of Muck Disposal Sites needs to be provided.
14. The Abstract of Trees and Enumeration list, duly authenticated by the concerned DFO, needs to be provided.

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15. Area Statement involving Forest land mentioning Khasra no. duly authenticated by the concerned DFO needs to be provided.
16. In Part II, column – 14, the District profile and geographical area is incorrect. Needful may be done in this regard.
17. As per DSS analysis, the proposed area for diversion is given 3.677 ha, but as calculated on DSS Portal, it is found to be 1.44 ha. Therefore necessary corrections in the KML file may be carried out. The revised KML file may be uploaded.
18. NoC/Sale deed for non-forest land acquired from private individuals is required to be submitted.
19. As per the geologist report provided it is clearly mentioned that the proposed alignment falls in steeply sloping hilly terrain. State Govt. may provide details of the mitigation measures to be adopted to arrest the accelerated soil erosion/landslide during/after execution of the project. If the area is vulnerable to erosion, then the Soil Moisture Conservation Plan (SMC), along with its cost of implementation as per MoEF&CC dated 07.06.2022, may be submitted
20. State Govt. may update information under column 6, Part- II online.
21. As per the information provided under column 4 (ii) a total **932 trees** are getting affected which included **543 saplings and 151 trees** of Ban (*Quercus spp*) trees which is ecologically important tree. Another alternate alignment may be considered for minimizing trees to be affected.
22. KML files show that the land proposed for CA has an exposed bare rock surface. Therefore, the State Govt. may provide the possibility of plantation in such a site. If required, suitable CA site may be explored
23. In Part II, column – 14, the District profile and geographical area are incorrect. Needful may be done in this regard
24. The Recommendation letters uploaded under columns 16 and 17 of online Part-II do not have the proposal number and date. The same may be reviewed, rectified, and uploaded online
