PROPOSAL NO. FP/UK/ROAD/11625/2015

- 1. Short narrative of the proposal does not provide adequate information in online Part I.
- 2. Total period for which forest land to be diverted is not mentioned in Part I.
- 3. Component wise break up is not provided in online Part I. The component wise break up should include area marked for various component viz. road, muck disposal etc.
- 4. As per the village wise break up two villages are involved in the area proposed for diversion but the village level committee proceedings provided pertaining to only one village. The State Govt may provide the VLC proceedings for other village also.
- 5. The State Govt has provided/uploaded the scanned copy of GIS software generated geo referenced digital map without showing geo coordinates to the exact scale of the proposed road at 200-300m including all turns. The State Govt may provide/upload the correct clear map showing geo coordinates at 200 to 300 m interval along the alignment including all turning points and ensure the uploading of correct revised map in online Part I.
- 6. The tree enumeration carried out for 7m width but the width of the road as per land schedule is 9m, therefore the revised tree enumeration list may provide and upload in online Part II for taking width of 9m.
- 7. The Eco class as per the tree species concern is not seems correct. The State Govt may review the Eco class of the area and provide revised NPV calculation accordingly.
- 8. The area marked for muck dumping in non forest land having capacity of only 1540 cum but the material need to be dumped in dumping yards calculated as 7437 cum. The State Govt may clarify that where will the remaining material dump?
