Please refer to your office letter No.D.VIII-152(M)/4530 dated 22.8.2016 received online on the subject cited proposal. 31

2. In reply to observation of this office, it is informed that the user agency has not violated the provisions of FCA,1980 and the user agency ie HPPWD has submitted that they are not in a position to include the said road in the list of 2183 road proposals. The local residents /inhabitants have improved old traditional path to jeepable standard about 30-35 years ago. A certificate of concerned gram Panchyat has been placed at P.No.68 of the proposal folder.

3. The said road is not appearing in the list of violation cases whereas as per joint inspection done by the committee (P.No.64-65 of proposal folder), the road has been inspected in view of CWP No.5600 of 2012 of Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh.

4. As the case does not pertain to the list of 2183 Roads, constructed in violation of FCA and for which joint Inspection was done on the behest of Hon'ble High Court of HP and is in addition to those roads.Thus as per requirement of FCA guidelines, the detailed report on violation w.r.t extent and reasons of violation in the form of self contained note supported by requisite documents, as per para 1.9 of guidelines under FCA, is to be submitted by DFO concerned in the instant case.In the hard copy of the Part-II also, against column No.9, DFO has categorically said yes to the violation.


It is, therefore, advised to submit detailed report on violation w.r.t extent and reasons of violation in the form of self contained note supported by requisite documents, as required under para 1.9 of chapter I of FCA guidelines.And also explain reasons under what circumstances the joint inspection of the said road despite not included in the list of 2183 roads was carried out.
