Sub: -Diversion of 14.979 ha. Forest land for Rehabilitation and Up-gradation of Amravati-Nandagaon –Morshi –Warud-Pandurna National Highway Pacakge-II.

The Conservator of Forest (T), Amravati vide letter dated 18/07/2022 has submitted query compliance to this office subject mentioned above. Following descriptions has been noticed after scrutiny of this proposal:-

- 1) A Public Interest Litigation No.29/2019 has been filed in Hon'ble Bombay High Court, Nagpur Bench by the Shri. Umesh Ambadas Hiwarale related to the violation of FCA, 1980 during widening of this project i.e., Warud Pandhurna Raod. Your are directed to submit the present status of this PIL.
- 2) After observation of KML file of CA land it is seen that there is good tree cover in proposed CA land, is divided by the major road, so in this regard clarification should be submitted along with satiability certificate.
- 3) Proper KML file with properties of diverted area should be submitted and Gut No.125, 126, 128, 25, 49, 40 & 36 are not highlighted in diverted area KML file.All forest survey/Gut no. should be highlighted.
- 4) There is need to ascertain the exact number of trees yet to be felled and trees felled without permission in this project. Consolidated statement should be submitted.
- 5) Correction to be done in Part-II, Site Inspection Report of DCF, Amravati and Online Part-II regarding number of trees to be felled.
- 6) User Agency has submitted CA scheme for 7 years but the C.A scheme should be submitted for 10 years.
- 7) NPV certificate to be submitted as per Government of India latest guidelines dated 06/01/2022.

8) Action taken report as per violation report need to be submitted.

The above need to be compiled at the earliest to this office.
