Sir,

Please refer to this office letter under reference (i) above, I am directed to inform that State Govt was requested to submit certain information as raised by Ministry. The proposals mentioned under subject above has observed to be located in the mining zone near to Bheluguri Stone Mahal and other 4 Nos. of approved mining proposals. State Govt is therefore requested to furnish the following information:-

1. To provide a cumulative impact study considering the holistic landscape and distance of the nearby mines i.e., the currently under processed proposals (i.e., Bheleuguri, Beldenga and Lankanjuri) and four numbers of approved proposals (Bipin Stone Mahal, Modertoli Stone Mahal No.2, Modertoli Stone Mahal No.3 and Modertoli Stone Mahal No.4)
2. State Govt to clarify whether the proposed area falls within no development zone or not?
3. Whether the proposed area is a part of any Eco-Sensitive Zone of nearby protected area or not?
4. State Govt to submit a holistic and comprehensive human elephant conflict management plan for the entire landscape around the proposed area.

State Govt. is requested to furnish the above information to this office at the earliest for further processing of the proposal.


