2. Comprehensive Wildlife mitigation plan as recommended by the REC;
3. The FDO /CF / Field Director, Project Tiger, Kawal Tiger Reserve, Nirmal recommended the following " **Since there is a good alternative road connectivity by constructing one bridge over Kaddam River from Shetpally to Yapalguda, which is also reduce the road length, the User Agency can avoid the propose road passing through the cores areas of Kawal Tiger Reserve for a length about 4.0378 KMs, which will be fragmenting the typical tiger habitat into two segments**". Hence, State Government may comment on above alternative and specific recommendation on the same may please be furnished.
