In the reference 1st cited, an online proposal was uploaded by the Block Development Officer, Pallipattu Panchayat Union, Pallipattu for the diversion of 0.133 Ha. of Reserve Forest land in Konasamuthiram Reserved Forest for construction of road in the existing cart track mud road having right of way of Cherlopalli road in Pallipattu Taluk of Tiruvallur Forest Division.

In the letter 3rd cited, the District Forest Officer, Tiruvallur Division has submitted his field inspection, recommendation report along with related hard copies.


On perusal of the proposal, it is seen that the District Forest Officer has recommended for 3.2 m. width only for the proposed road. He has not made any provisions for brim portion along both side of the road. Hence, he is requested to clarify whether 3.2 m. width is sufficient for the above road. Incase of provision has to be made for brim portion the area required for brim portion may also be included and revised proposal submitted accordingly.

Further, as per para 2.5 of special provisions for CA for certain categories of the projects CA shall be raised and maintained at the cost of User Agency on degraded forest land in twice in extent of the forest area to be diverted for the projects. Hence, cost required for raising CA in twice the extent of forest land to be diverted may also be worked out and included in the project proposal.
