

Construction of MR from Dhari Block Mukhyalay to Kasiyalekh-Dhari-Parwara MR via Kaul-Dhanachuli in Nainital District (1.7425 ha)

The reply of this office EDS dated 26.12.2016 has been uploaded by the State Govt. vide letter dated 13.9.2017. Following shortcomings still remain in the reply/proposal:-

1. Although, the GIS software generated geo referenced digital map of the forest land proposed for diversion has been uploaded at para-C of online Part-I now but this map has not been authenticated by DFO and original hard copy has also not been submitted for placing in the hard copy of the proposal.
2. Although, the GIS software generated geo referenced digital map of the land proposed for CA has been uploaded at para-L of online Part-I now but this map has not been authenticated by DFO and original hard copy has also not been submitted for placing in the hard copy of the proposal.
3. It is seen from the NPV calculation submitted now that the density is mentioned as 0.3 in Eco class- V but the NPV rate has been charged for dense forest category i.e. 8.45 lakh per ha instead of 6.57 lakh per ha applicable for 0.3 density i.e open forest.
4. It is seen from the land schedule that 1.5225 ha (1.0325 ha Civil Soyam land & 0.49 ha Van Panchayat land) is required for construction of road and another 0.27 ha land is require for muck dumping, making the total requirement of forest land as 1.7925 ha. But, the area of forest land required for construction of Road is mentioned as 1.2525 ha and the land required for muck dumping as 0.49 ha making the total as 1.7425 ha which has been proposed for diversion. Thus, the total forest land mentioned in the land schedule i.e. 1.7925 ha does not tally with the forest land mentioned in online Part-I & Part-II i.e. 1.7425 ha.
5. It is seen from the enumeration list that the total no. of trees above 10 cm dia comes to 80 trees but the no. of trees is mentioned as 72 trees in the online Part-II.

State Govt. may remove above shortcoming and submit revised documents /information/clarification and also upload the documents wherever required.
