Nagpur's office note vide letter under reference 1. In the said note Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (WL) has clearly mentioned that, prior approval or clearance from National Board for Wild Life is mandatory in accordance with sections 38 O (1) (g) of Wildlife Protection Act 1972.

It was also communicated that, User Agency shall be informed regarding submitting a proposal to National Board for Wild Life on the subject mentioned above. But after issuing such clear instructions regarding proposal under subject, your office just wasting this and your office time by forwarding undertakings of User Agency.

It is now clearly informed that, if specific instructions issued regarding any proposal by Govt. of India, State Govt. or this office, it is mandatory for your office to submit its compliance accordingly.

Hence, it is once again requested to inform User Agency regarding submitting a proposal to National Board for Wild Life and seeking mitigation measures on the subject mentioned above.
