
I am to invite your attention to the subject and reference cited above. Assistant Engineer, KSEB (Electrical Section) Vithura has submitted a proposal for diversion of 0.006 ha of forest land from Paruthipally Range of Thiruvananthapuram Division for providing service connection to Sri. Suju R. Suju Bhavan, Orupara, Mankala, Vithura under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The proposal received through online mode has been forwarded to the concerned Divisional Forest Officer and District Collector for the due procedures under Forest Conservation Rules 2003 and Amendment Rules 2014. But it may be seen that the required certificate regarding settlement of rights under Scheduled Tribe and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Rights) Act 2006 to be issued by District Collector has not yet been furnished. As per Rule 6(3)F of Forest (Conservation) Rules 2003 and Forest

Conservation)Amendment Rules 2014 every forest clearance proposals should include the certificate regarding settlement of rights of tribals under Forest Rights act 2006 issued by District Collector concerned. As per the guidelines issued by Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change vide reference 3rd cited. The above certificate is mandatory for getting approval from Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India.

As per reference 1st cited Government has directed to submit the certificate of settlement of rights under Forest Rights Act 2006 from District Collector.

Hence you are hereby requested to take urgent action to issue the above certificate as per the provisions of Forest Conservation Rules 2003 and guidelines issued hereunder. Please treat this as most urgent.
