Sir,

With reference to the subject and reference, it is to inform that the subject proposal was considered by the Regional Empowered Committee (REC), IRO Chennai in its 50th meeting held on 21.09.2021 and after detailed deliberation, the committee recommended the proposal subject to following conditions;

1. The comprehensive wildlife mitigation measures plan needs to be submitted to SC-NBWL for concurrence and all conditions imposed by NBWL, if any shall be complied with by the State / User Agency;
2. No tree felling shall be carried out in the forest area proposed for diversion;
3. Only all weather road shall be constructed and road shall not be Black topped;
4. All conditions recommended by Forest Division Officer, Kagaznagar Forest Division & Chief Conservator of Forests, Adilabad shall be complied with by the State / User Agency;
5. Working permission shall not be accorded to this project, till the project gets approval from NBWL.

In connection to the above, it is requested that the following information / documents may please be furnished at the earliest for further consideration of the proposal; It may kindly be noted that the proposal will be dealt in terms of the Guideline 12.4 of the Hand Book and will be further processed only upon the recommendation of the SCNBWL is obtained and furnished by the state government.

1. Approval of SC- NBWL;
2. Comprehensive wildlife mitigation measures plan approved by the SC-NBWL.
