With reference to the subject and reference, it is to inform that the subject proposal was considered by the Regional Empowered Committee (REC), IRO Chennai in its 50th meeting held on 21.09.2021 and after detailed deliberation, the committee defer the proposal and decided to consider the proposal after receipt of the following;

1. The comprehensive wildlife mitigation measures plan needs to be submitted to SC-NBWL for concurrence and all conditions imposed by NBWL, if any shall be complied with by the State / User Agency;
2. About coming up of large number of roads in these wildlife areas, may also be intimated to SBWL and NBWL by the State Government while submitting the proposal for wildlife clearance;
3. Working permission shall not be accorded to this project, till the project gets approval from NBWL.

In connection to the above, it is requested that the following information / documents may please be furnished at the earliest for further consideration of the proposal; It may kindly be noted that the proposal will be dealt in terms of the Guideline 12.4 of the Hand Book and will be further processed only upon the recommendation of the SCNBWL is obtained and furnished by the state government.

1. Approval of SC- NBWL;
2. Comprehensive wildlife mitigation measures plan approved by the SC-NBWL.
3. About coming up of large number of roads in these wildlife areas, may also be intimated to SBWL and NBWL by the State Government while submitting the proposal for wildlife clearance;
