

**33/11 KV SUBSTATION AT GULAR IN DOGI PATTI OF NARENDRANAGAR BLOCK
IN TEHRI DISTRICT**

The reply of this office EDS dated 28.04.2016 has been submitted by the State Govt. vide letter dated 23.07.2016 uploaded on 25.07.2016. Some shortcomings still remain in the proposal, the details of which is given below:

1. In reply to point no. 2, it is mentioned that authority letter was already attached in the proposal in the past. But, it is seen from para-A-3 of online Part-I that the authority letter is issued in favour of Shri Amit Kumar but the online application is made by Shri Shakti Prasad.
2. In reply to point no.4, it is mentioned that the certificate about NPV calculation is attached as additional document in online Part-I. But, NPV calculation sheet showing Eco-class & density of the forest land proposed for diversion and the NPV rate charged has not been found uploaded in additional documents in online Part-I.
3. In reply to point no. 6 of EDS, it is mentioned that the forest land has been selected for substation because no other suitable land is available near the proposed site. But, the detail note containing justification for locating project in forest land is still not attached in para-D (i) of online Part-I. Moreover, this is a non-site specific project which can be established anywhere in the area.
4. In reply to point no.7 of EDS, it is mentioned that necessary corrections has been made in para-14 of online Part-II and the information about forest land diverted, CA stipulated and progress of CA has also been provided in the prescribed format given by the Regional Office. But, it is seen from the data given in para-14 of online Part-II that the forest land diverted, **CA stipulated** and progress of CA is 652.467 ha, **902.85** ha & 902.85 ha respectively, whereas these figures are given as 652.467 ha for the forest land diverted, **1156.246 ha for the CA stipulated** & 902.85 ha for the progress of CA in the format. Thus, it is seen that the data given about CA stipulated in para-14 of online Part-II and the format do not tally. Moreover, the CA stipulated is not commensurate to the forest land diverted.
5. In reply to point no.8 of EDS, it is mentioned that the forest land proposed for diversion is kept in the Social and Economic Management Working Circle but no such Working Circle is proposed in the draft Working Plan (2013-14 to 2022-23) of Narendranagar Forest Division.

State Govt. is requested to remove the shortcomings mentioned above and submit required information/documents/clarification.
