A/MoEFCC/23/208 dated 23rd August, 2023 on the above subject requesting this Ministry to advise the State Government not to insist for CA land and CA charges in respect of mining leases which have been provided deemed extension of FC approval co-terminus with the lease period granted under the MMDR Act, 1957. In this connection, it is to inform that the matter has been discussed by the Advisory Committee in its meeting held on 11.10.2023. Based on the recommendation of the Advisory Committee and approval of the same by the competent authority in the MoEF&CC, New Delhi, the Central Government hereby clarifies that in such cases, involving broken up forest areas prior to 1980, the provisions of compensatory afforestation and NPV, if not paid earlier, will remain applicable.
