The Telangana Drinking Water Supply project to Nirmal , Boath and Adilabad Assembly Constituencies in Adilabad District segmen-21 was administratively sanctioned for Rs 1530.00(Phase-II) crores by the Government of Telangana to provide safe drinking water to all the households at their door steps in the project area.

This segment-21 covers two Assembly Constituencies namely Nirmal, Boath and Adilabad. The proposed project is most important to mitigate the Drinking water Scarcity in summer for drought and flourosis problem in the area by providing safe drinking water.


Providing safe drinking water from Intake well constructed near Sri ram sagar Irrigation Project on Godavari river as source and Pumping to Madegaon Water treatment plant to the project area will improve not only the health but also the living standards of the people in the area. In addition to above, substantial economic gain in terms of reduced health hazards and reduced work burden on women folk will be achieved.

Part of the pipe lines pass through reserve forest area of Nirmal & Adilabad Divisions and part of Kawal wild life Sanctuary Conserve Forest. The existing drinking water facilities are based on ground water which are very poor in quality and insufficient to cater the need of the people in the area. As such it is proposed to provide comprehensive drinking water from safe surface source of Intake well at Sri ram sagar Project on Godavari River to the people in the area.
